## High School English Teacher (Grades 9-12)

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Covenant Christian Academy is seeking a qualified secondary school professional in the area of English education. The candidate for this position should hold a Bachelor's degree (Masters preferred) in English or Literature and have experience teaching English at the secondary school level (Classical School experience preferred). The candidate must have mastery of the field(s), the ability to flourish in our distinctly Christian and Classical model, the ability to teach in the Socratic method, and a passion for teaching English and Writing through dynamic curricula that integrate written and spoken English.

This Upper School faculty position may include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Plan and teach English courses taught to Rhetoric School students in grades 9-12
- Collaborate with Humanities teachers (English, History, Bible, Rhetoric) to build Classical content into all humanities classes (roundtable discussion, classical arrangement for essay writing, convincing and winsome public speaking).
- Oversee curriculum review and recommendations for the English program.
- Work with Humanities teachers to teach the Senior Thesis course (this is a summative assessment and a graduation requirement) as well as orchestrate the Oral Defense Day of Senior Thesis projects in the spring.
- Participate in weekly faculty meetings, attend a limited number of outside of school hour events, and willingly engage with the school community in a way that is supportive of students and fellow teachers.
- Be available during set hours each week to work with students individually for tutoring and/or coaching in the area of close reading and classically arranged writing.
- Have a working knowledge and experience with computer technology and computer software for educational applications is valuable and essential.
- Must be willing to sign CCA's Statement of Faith and Core Values. Must maintain the highest Christian virtue and personal decorum, serving as a Christian role model and mentor both in and out of school, to students, parents, fellow faculty members and employees in judgment, dignity, respect, and Christian living.

The Upper School English Faculty position is a full time position with benefits. Supplemental income from after-school programs and/or individual tutoring may be available.

**Contract runs:** September 2018 through June 2019; teaching is on a 10 month cycle.
