



INCOMING LOGIC SCHOOL (GRADES 7-8) SUMMER READING

At Covenant, we believe it is important to ask students to do some thought-provoking reading over the summer to keep them engaged with ideas as well as logic, argument, and winsome expression. To that end we ask that rising 7th and 8th graders read *The Case for Faith: Student Edition* by Lee Strobel.

In this book, author Lee Strobel outlines six “Objections” to the Christian faith and explains how each can be answered. A simple writing assignment is due on Friday, September 8, to show that a student has read the book.

Students are required to...

Choose one of Strobel’s “objections” and summarize it. Then, reflect on why that objection seemed most interesting or most helpful to you personally. The one page summary and reflection can be hand-written or typed and should be about 1 typed, double spaced page, or about 300 words.

Mr. MacDonald, our Logic School Bible teacher, will read these assignments and give them credit on a pass/fail basis. Mr. MacDonald will also make reference to this book in his Bible 7 and Bible 8 classes.

You may borrow the book from a library, but we encourage students to buy the book, so they may write in it and “make it their own” as they engage with the ideas and make notes in the margins.
