100TH DAY OF SCHOOL DONATION DRIVE JANUARY 27TH–FEBRUARY 12TH

Each year, in recognition of our 100th day of school, CCA partners with Citizens Inn Haven from Hunger to coordinate a school-wide food drive to help those experiencing food insecurity. We are humbled by the need and will be collecting food items again this year to assist.

Citizens Inn Haven from Hunger operates transitional, sober, and emergency housing shelters to combat homelessness and provides a food pantry and a community meals program to families and individuals struggling to put food on the table. The food pantry provides residents in more than 1,100 Peabody, Salem, and Lynnfield households with fresh fruits and vegetables, meat, dairy, and canned goods each month. The Inn distributes more than 2 million pounds of food each year. The community meals program offers guests a filling, nutritious supper in a friendly atmosphere four nights a week. Approximately 15,600 meals are served annually.

OUR GOAL IS TO COLLECT 100 OF EACH OF THESE REQUESTED ITEMS AT EACH GRADE LEVEL TO EQUAL MORE THAN 1,400 ITEMS!

GRAMMAR SCHOOL ITEMS NEEDED:

- PreS and PreK: Plastic wrap, ZipLock bags
- K: Aluminum foil
- Gr 1: Tuna or chicken (in pouches/ring-pull tops only)
- Gr 2: Dried spices (red pepper flakes/garlic powder/paprika/oregano, etc.)
- Gr 3: Sugar for home baking
- Gr 4: Cooking oil (vegetable, olive, canola, etc.)
- Gr 5: Salt for baking
- Gr 6: Salad Dressing (all varieties)

Please put all donations in your grade level box: PreS–K outside classrooms; 1st–6th in PAAC connector hallway.

UPPER SCHOOL ITEMS NEEDED:

- Gr 7: Kids' snacks for lunch boxes (ind. packs)
- Gr 8: Cup cake liners and birthday candles
- Gr 9: Cake frosting
- Gr 10: Boxed-cake mix
- Gr 11: Cereal (kid-friendly, healthy ones preferred)
- Gr 12: Pancake syrup/maple syrup

Please put all donations in your grade level box in the USLR lobby.

Note: In addition to grade level, USLR will also be awarded House Cup points by most participation (not quantity of items).
