- Students in grades Pre-K through 6 will remain in their classrooms for the duration of the night.
- The concert will be recorded and made available to families at a later date.
- The concert will be presented in grade level order. There will be a brief intermission between grades 3 and 4 so that parents with younger students can leave if they would like. This will open up seats on the floor for those in the bleachers.

## ARRIVAL TIMES

**Grade 4, 5 & 6 Bands:** Please arrive at CCA on Wednesday at 5:40 PM to warm-up and tune-up - please report to the PAAC upon arrival.

**Grammar School String Ensembles:** Please arrive at CCA on Wednesday at 5:40 PM to warm-up and tune-up. GS String Ensemble students will meet with Mrs. Mitts in the PAAC locker room hallway.

**All Other GS Music Students:** Please plan to arrive at CCA on Wednesday between 5:30 and 5:45pm, but <u>no later than 5:45 PM</u>. Students are to go directly to their classroom where their teachers will meet them. Teachers will not be in their classrooms prior to 5:30pm, so please do not send your child down to their classroom until at least 5:30pm.

**All Upper School Musicians (Grades 7-12):** Please plan to arrive at CCA at 5:45pm on Thursday for final set up, warm up and sound check. All students will meet in the PAAC upon arrival.

#### PLEASE BE ON TIME! THIS WILL GREATLY HELP THE EVENING RUN SMOOTHLY.

All GS students will return to their grade level classrooms following their performance and parents can pick up their children at the end of the concert or at intermission if they have finished performing. We would ask that no students remain in the PAAC in order to allow for adequate seating for parents and family friends. All students should be under adult supervision at all times. Please note that there is no food, drink, or high heels allowed in the PAAC. Please leave the PAAC as you found it upon arrival, throwing trash away on your way out.

## GRAMMAR SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The following dress code will apply:

- <u>Pre-K through Grade 3 General Music Students</u> are to come dressed in their "Sunday best." If you would like to dress similarly to those in the ensembles, see below.
- ALL Students in Grades 4-6 and String Ensemble:
  - GIRLS: Black dress pants (<u>no leggings or jeans!</u>) or black skirt (skirt length must be <u>ankle length</u>), <u>solid white</u> blouse <u>with sleeves</u> (cap, short, ¾ or full length), and black dress shoes or sandals (preferably no sneakers unless this is all you have, but <u>must</u> be all black, no high heels and shoes must be non-marking shoes). Simple earrings and/or a necklace are allowed. <u>Please note that if a student is not dressed appropriately, they will be asked to change their clothes and their grade will be docked.</u>
  - BOYS: Black dress pants, solid <u>WHITE</u> Oxford shirt with short or long sleeves and collar, black socks and black shoes (preferably no sneakers unless this is all you have, but <u>must</u> be black), and a tie of your choice as long as it does not have writing or cartoons. No jackets, vests, sports coats, etc. <u>Please note that if a student is not dressed appropriately, they will be asked to change their clothes and their grade will be docked one letter grade.</u>

## **USLR DRESS CODE**

The following dress code will apply:

GIRLS: Black dress pants (<u>no leggings or jeans!</u>) or black skirt (skirt length must be <u>ankle length</u>), solid white blouse <u>with sleeves</u> (cap, short, ¾ or full length), and black dress shoes or sandals (preferably no sneakers unless this is all you have, but <u>must</u> be all black, no high heels and shoes must be non-marking shoes). Simple earrings and/or a necklace are allowed. <u>Please note that if a student is not</u> <u>dressed appropriately, they will be asked to change their clothes and their grade will be docked.</u>

**BOYS:** Black dress pants, solid <u>WHITE</u> Oxford shirt with short or long sleeves and collar, black socks and black shoes (preferably no sneakers unless this is all you have, but <u>must</u> be black), and a tie of your choice as long as it does not have writing or cartoons. No jackets, vests, sports coats, etc. <u>Please note that if a student is not dressed appropriately, they will be asked to change their clothes and their grade will be docked one letter grade.</u>
