The Athletic Director's responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Provide a clear vision for the Athletic Program and set goals for appropriate growth.
- Hire and Manage Coaches for CCA's 14 athletic teams
- Manage team supplies; including uniforms, equipment, medical kit supplies
- Schedule team practices and games and maintain the online sports schedule
- Schedule & Rent External Fields and Courts as necessary.
- Schedule referees/umpires and athletic trainers for home games
- Schedule transportation for CCA teams to games
- Manage seasonal sports registration
- · Communicate well with coaches, parents and USLR staff regarding schedule, early release, injuries, etc.
- Represent CCA at league meetings with MBIL, IGC, NSBA, and NEPSAC.
- Manage end of season Sports Awards Banquet
- Manage the Athletic Budget
- Instruct Physical Education classes for Grammar School and Middle School Grades.

- Proven experience directing Athletic Programs in an Upper School setting with structure and a spirit of grace and community
- · Ability to hire and maintain a strong coaching staff and provide guidance and support to them
- Willingness to take initiative in developing the athletic program to complement the schools Christian and classical foundation
