It is always a privilege when our CCA community is able to support the efforts of local community service and support initiatives. Former CCA Librarian and Aftercare Program Director, Joanna Bergeron, now serving as an administrator for North Shore Baptist Church of Peabody, has reached out to invite our participation in a community initiative led by several local churches, supporting close to 90 migrant families relocated to Peabody this summer.

As winter approaches, the needs are great and we want to indeed be the hands and feet of Jesus. For the next two weeks we will be running a simple drop-off collection to support this collaborative effort. Most needed items include gently worn children's and maternity clothing, winter clothing, and baby gear. You can help by sharing your family's outgrown or unused items (clean, gently used & in good repair).

Due to storage reasons, we are asking that large items including strollers and playpens be dropped directly at North Shore Baptist Church, located at 706 Lowell Street (around the block from CCA). Please leave items at the red door. Smaller donated items may be dropped off in the CCA carline at drop off or pick up. Collection boxes will also be available at the CCA entrances. Donations will be received between September 20th-29th.

ITEMS URGENTLY NEEDED:

Children's Clothing – all ages/sizes

- Basic items, suitable for school
- Warm PJ's
- Shoes

Family Winter Gear – all adult & kids' sizes

Coats, Fleeces, Boots, Mittens, Gloves, Hats, Scarves

Maternity Clothes – basic pieces; all sizes

Baby Gear

- Clothes (basic kinds, esp. warm/winter) all sizes/ages
- Pack 'n' plays (+ sheets if possible)
- Strollers (especially needed!)
