English Language Learning Teacher Long Term Substitute (Grades 8-11)

Covenant Christian Academy is seeking a qualified secondary school professional in the area of E.L.L. education: specifically ELL 2 and ELL Advanced Writing. The candidate for this position should hold a Bachelor's degree in Education (Teaching English Language Learning) and have experience teaching E.L.L. at the secondary school level. The candidate must have mastery of the field(s), the ability to flourish in our distinctly Christian and classical model, and a passion for teaching E.L.L. and working with international students.

We are also looking for a long-term substitute in the area of teaching American Literature (English) to grades 11 and 12 (see additional job description). We are willing to treat these as one position for the person with the right qualifications or two distinct positions staffed by two people.

An Upper School faculty position includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Teach 1 section of E.L.L. 2 to a small class (2-3 students) meeting on 4 days of the week: Vocabulary, Grammar, Writing, Reading, Speaking/Listening.
- Plan to teach 1 section of E.L.L. Advanced Writing Students. Students are focusing on learning to write a classically arranged argument.
- Plan and supervise field trips where necessary to augment student learning and give them more hands on experience with English Language Learning.
- Teach 1 section of "Lost Generations" centered around 20th century American novels (Hemingway, Steinbeck, and Morrison). Follow curriculum set out by a lead teacher who teaches another section of the course.
- Attend a limited number of specified school events as a representative of the CCA Upper School faculty.
- Available to provide extra help sessions three times per week immediately after school hours.
- Working knowledge and experience with computer technology and computer software is valuable and essential.
- Candidate must be available Monday (7:45-9:00 and 11:00-12:00), Tuesday (8:45-9:45 and 2:15-3:30), Wednesday (7:45-9:45), Friday (7:45-9:00)

Applicants must be willing to sign CCA's Statement of Faith and Core Values. Must maintain the highest Christian virtue and personal decorum, serving as a Christian role model and mentor both in and out of school, to students, parents, fellow faculty members and employees in judgment, dignity, respect, and Christian living.

Contract runs: Mid-March 2019 through May 2019; The position is part-time position for ten weeks.
