

English Teacher Long Term Substitute (Grades 11-12)

Covenant Christian Academy is seeking a qualified secondary school professional in the area of secondary school English. The candidate for this position should hold a Bachelor's degree in Education (Teaching English) or a Bachelor's degree in English and have experience teaching English at the secondary school level. We are specifically looking for a person capable of teaching American Literature and scholarly writing to students in grades 11 and 12. The candidate must have mastery of the field(s), the ability to flourish in our distinctly Christian and classical model, and a passion for teaching English. We are willing to treat these as two distinct part time positions staffed by two people if necessary.

We are also looking for a long-term substitute in the area of teaching English Language Learning (E.L.L.) to grades 8-11 (see additional job description). We are willing to treat these as one position for the person with the right qualifications or two distinct positions staffed by two people.

An Upper School faculty position includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Teach 1 section of "Lost Generations" centered around 20th century American novels (Hemingway, Steinbeck, and Morrison). Follow curriculum set out by a lead teacher who teaches another section of the course.
- Teach students to write about literature in a scholarly manner using proper Chicago Style documentation.
- Attend a limited number of specified school events as a representative of the CCA Upper School faculty.
- Available to provide extra help sessions two times per week immediately after school hours.
- Working knowledge and experience with computer technology and computer software is valuable and essential.
- Candidate must be available Tuesday and Thursday (7:45-9:00AM), Wednesday and Friday (12:20-1:15PM)
