

## Additional COVID-19 related supplies for Grammar School Students: Fall 2020

## ALL GRAMMAR SCHOOL STUDENTS SHOULD HAVE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

## **Beach Towel** (kept in school)

All students in grades PK-6 should bring one beach towel (please NOT oversized) that can be easily rolled up and stored in their personal storage crate (provided by the school). Securing the rolled-up towel with a string elastic band is recommended.

<u>Umbrella</u> (kept in school) Small and retractable to approx. 12" or less

Rain Jacket/Rain Boots (kept at home, but brought to school during inclement weather)

<u>Cloth Face Masks:</u> students should be wearing one to school each day and have at least one spare available in his/her backpack. It is recommended that each student have 5-7 masks that can be rotated and laundered <u>daily</u>. Even PK-1 students should have a mask available at all times.

3 Dry Erase Markers (Blue or Black) if not already specified on grade level supply list

Adequate 1-1 Technology: We are planning to begin school in person but recognize that we may have to pivot to remote learning at any time. If and when this happens school will continue on a regular schedule and therefore, it is highly recommended that all students have access to technology needed for remote learning. Unlike during the spring, we will not be able to cater schedules to avoid grade level conflicts for children sharing devices. It is highly suggested that parents invest in a tablet, Chromebook or computer that their student can use. Our remote learning platform will work equally as well on both Mac and PC. Many of our Grammar School families have reported being pleased with a set up for their younger students that includes an iPad with an attachable keyboard and Apple Pencil (not required)
