

In November 2022, Covenant launched an important strategic growth initiative named "God's Not Done Yet!" This 5-year, \$10 million initiative recognizes God's past faithfulness and His clear desire to enhance our ability to develop future Christian leaders equipped with truth to do His work.

Specifically, "God's Not Done Yet" will advance Covenant's mission in the following three phases through:

Phase I (completed September 2023) ✓:

- Developing a USLR Academic Enrichment program and constructing an Academic Enrichment Center.
- Adding new Logic School classrooms, administrative offices, science labs, and teacher workspaces.
- Creating new art rooms, music classrooms, and recording studios.

Phase II (expected completion by 2028):

- Adding Rhetoric School classrooms and mixed-use space for our Grammar School.
- Creating faculty and staff meeting space and workrooms.
- Repaving entire parking lot.
- Replacing aging HVAC system.

Phase III (expected completion by 2028):

- Constructing our own 13,000 sq. ft. auditorium space with seating for 350 to serve our Fine Arts, Chapel, and community programs as they continue to grow and thrive.
- Acquiring exclusive rights to Kennedy Fields from the City of Peabody in exchange for building the City new fields for their use.
- Fully funding Covenant's "Charis Fund," an endowment with the purpose of making CCA's educational experience more accessible and ensuring that CCA serves generations to come.
