We do encourage you to use sturdy plastic shoeboxes whenever possible, however, this year we will provide a cardboard box/ per GS Family at your request. Durable plastic shoeboxes become a valuable part of the gift to those in need. Additional cardboard boxes will be available upon request as supplies last.

All filled shoeboxes must be returned to school by <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>Nov. 15 at 8:00AM</u>. <u>Late boxes may not be accepted due to delivery deadlines</u>. Please use the included labels to attach to filled shoeboxes before returning!

<u>Please note the suggested fee of \$10.00/shoebox for shipping charges.</u> This helps support the good work of Samaritan's Purse as they undertake this amazing project. The fee is payable by check to Samaritan's Purse and should be included inside the shoebox. (One check can be used for multiple boxes.)

Though you may feel inundated by charitable requests at this time of year, we have found that these hands on service initiatives help our students to connect with the ideas of poverty, privilege, and the command to demonstrate compassion for those in need.

NON-LIQUID **HYGIENE ITEMS**

- toothbrushes
- bar soap

- combs

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- pens, pencils, and sharpeners

- notebooks and paper coloring and picture books
- solar calculators

A PERSONAL NOTE

- a message to the child
- · a photo of yourself, your family, or group

- hair bows
